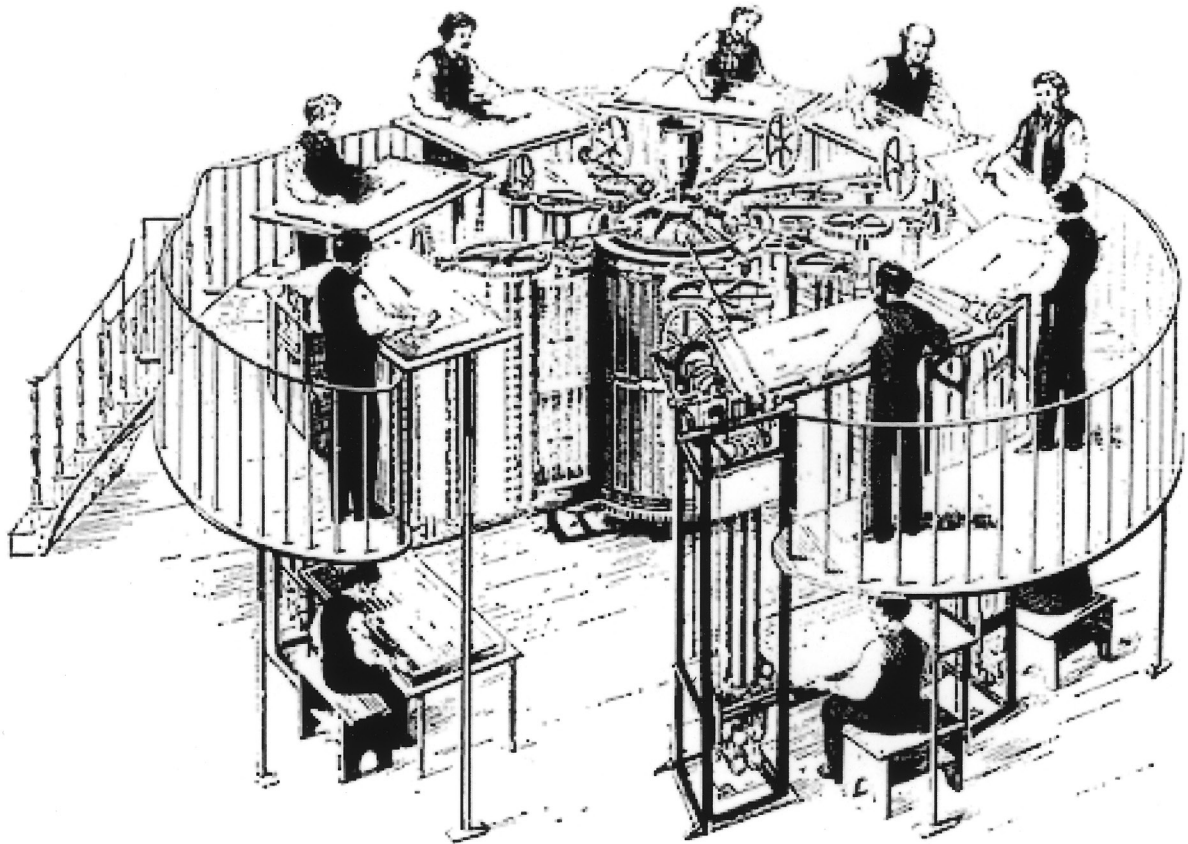


# Applegath's vertical printing machine

Installed at "The Times" in 1848.



## The Applegath Vertical Printing Press

In 1848, the *Times* replaced a flatbed press, constructed by Augustus Applegath and Edward Cowper twenty years earlier, with a vertical rotary press devised by Applegath alone that could produce 6,000-8,000 single-sided sheets per hour, depending on the skill of the eight paper feeders.
