A bill to amend section 402 of Act No. 453 of the Public Acts of 1976,
entitled as amended

"Elliott-Larsen civil rights act,"

being section 37.2402 of the Compiled Laws of 1970.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 402 of Act No. 453 of the Public Acts of 1976, being
2 section 37.2402 of the Compiled Laws of 1970, is amended to read as follows:

3 Sec. 402. An educational institution shall not:

4 (a) Discriminate against an individual in the full utilization of or
5 benefit from the institution, or the services, activities, or programs provided
6 by the institution because of religion, race, color, national origin, or sex.

7 (b) Exclude, expel, limit, or otherwise discriminate against an individual
8 seeking admission as a student or an individual enrolled as a student in the
9 terms, conditions, or privileges of the institution, because of religion, race,
10 color, national origin, or sex.

1 (c) For purposes of admission only, make or use a written or oral inquiry
2 or form of application that elicits or attempts to elicit information concern-
3 ing the religion, race, color, national origin, age, sex, or marital status of
4 a person, except as permitted by rule of the commission or as required by
5 federal law, rule, or regulation, or pursuant to an affirmative action program.

6 (d) Print or publish or cause to be printed or published a catalog,
7 notice, or advertisement indicating a preference, limitation, specification, or
8 discrimination based on the religion, race, color, national origin, or sex of
9 an applicant for admission to the educational institution.

10 (e) Announce or follow a policy of denial or limitation through a quota
11 or otherwise of educational opportunities of a group or its members because of
12 religion, race, color, national origin, or sex.

13 (F) ENCOURAGE OR CONDONE [LEGALLY REQUIRED] DISCRIMINATION AGAINST AN
INDIVIDUAL ON THE

14 BASIS OF RACE, RELIGION, COLOR, NATIONAL ORIGIN, OR SEX BY [] MAKING OR
15 MAINTAINING AFTER JULY 4, 1979, AN INVESTMENT IN A CORPORATION, PARTNERSHIP,
16 OR ASSOCIATION OR SUBSIDIARY OR AFFILIATE OF A CORPORATION, PARTNERSHIP OR
17 ASSOCIATION WHICH [ENCOURAGES] OR CONDONES THROUGH ITS ACTIONS OR INACTIONS,
18 [LEGALLY REQUIRED] DIS-
19 CRIMINATION AGAINST AN INDIVIDUAL ON THE BASIS OF RACE, RELIGION, COLOR,
NATIONAL ORIGIN, OR SEX.

I. It is illegal under South African law for black South Africans:

1. TO BUY LAND
2. TO VOTE
3. TO TRAVEL WITHOUT A PASS BOOK
4. TO ORGANIZE POLITICALLY
5. TO TAKE EFFECTIVE ACTION THRU LABOR UNIONS
6. TO BE UNEMPLOYED

II. American investment in South Africa is large and continually growing. It is illegal under South African law for American corporations to advocate these rights - even were they so inclined, which they aren't.

III. The Sullivan principles - adopted by some corporations - even where applied - do not answer to the free survival of black South Africans.

IV. Black South African leaders have asked that American corporations leave because the American corporate presence aids in the perpetuation of this repressive regime.
