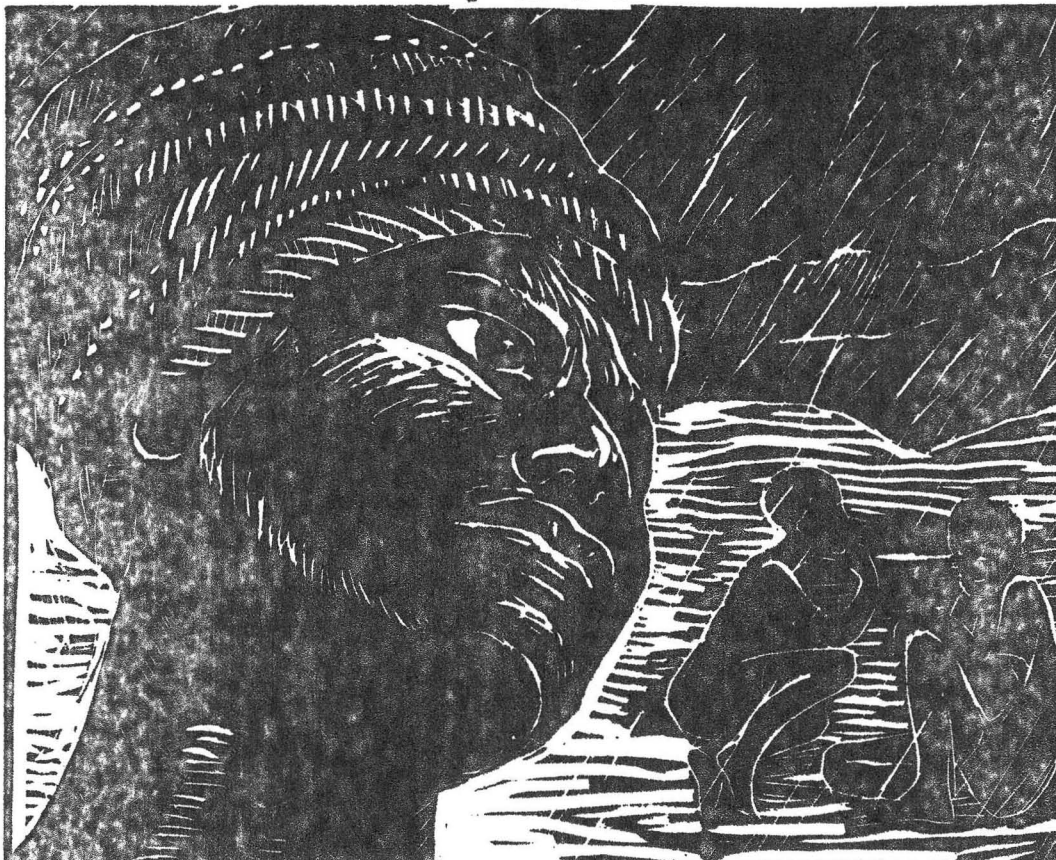


# FOR

CLOTHING

ZIMBABWE



The Southern Africa Support Committee is conducting a drive to collect clothes for the freedom fighters and refugees who are struggling against the apartheid government in Zimbabwe (Rhodesia).

The freedom fighters of Zimbabwe are presently in a liberation struggle to end the oppressive rule of the white minority government there. Many Zimbabweans have been forced to leave the homelands or face imprisonment, torture, and death at the hands of the racist Smith regime. These refugees (many of them children) are in desperate need of clothing and other supplies. In February, the Southern Africa Support Committee contributed several tons of clothing to the eighty-seven (87) tons that were shipped to Africa from San Francisco. With the help of the International Longshoreman and Warehousemen's Union (Local # 13), we hope to ship another eighty-seven (87) tons of clothing to Africa.
