

Educators Against Apartheid

Educators Against Apartheid is dedicated to education and action to help end apartheid.

Divestment: E.A.A. singled out several corporations with investments in South Africa. These include AETNA Life and Casualty, MacMillan Publishers, McGraw Hill Publishers, Readers Digest and Kelloggs. We are conducting a campaign to urge these corporations to divest. So far, AETNA and MacMillan HAVE DIVESTED. We have launched a boycott against McGraw Hill products because of their most racist and patronizing attitude about Black people in South Africa.

E.A.A. is conducting a campaign to urge the United Federation of Teachers and the Board of Education to adopt a policy of full divestment of the Teachers Retirement System. We encourage you to write to them about this issue.

Education: E.A.A. conducted several educational forums. E.A.A. prepared a resource list for educators and students who are involved in learning about apartheid. E.A.A. has met with the Board of Education to urge the dissemination of educational materials in the schools, organization of teach-ins, poster and essay contests, and curriculum development. E.A.A. is encouraging high school teachers to use the curriculum guide by William Bigelow - Strangers in their own Country. It was published by Africa World Press in Trenton, N.J. E.A.A. is preparing a curriculum kit about apartheid. It will be for elementary school children. The kit will include a filmstrip and cassette and hands-on activities. Please contact E.A.A. if you have some material for this kit.

Action: E.A.A. has participated in city-wide demonstrations against apartheid. Our members have organized activities in our classes, schools, and school districts. We have sent delegations to the U.F.T., McGraw Hill, and the Board of Education. E.A.A. and several high school students met with the United Nations Centre Against Apartheid. E.A.A. is involved in lobbying for legislation to bring an end to apartheid.

E.A.A. BELIEVES THAT EDUCATORS ARE IN A POSITION TO REACH THOUSANDS OF CHILDREN, EDUCATORS, AND PARENTS AND TO INVOLVE THEM IN THE STRUGGLE TO END APARTHEID. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF FREEDOM LOVING PEOPLE TO JOIN THIS WORLD-WIDE EFFORT TO BRING AN END TO APARTHEID.
