Dean Acheson has supported the ABM, has supported the Vietnam War, and has consistently supported white racism and Portuguese colonialism in Southern Africa.

Acheson has consistently opposed sanctions for Rhodesia and is frequently praised by right-wing organizations with special interests in Southern Africa.

Acheson has consistently identified himself with Portuguese colonialism; praised Salazar in his memoirs, argued for continued friendship with Portugal. He has written the forward to a new book by the Foreign Minister of Portugal, Franco Nogueira. The book, entitled the Third World, is a justification of Portuguese colonialism.
