

DO YOU WANT TO HELP END CUNY'S SUPPORT OF SOUTH AFRICAN RACISM?

- FACT:** Under South African apartheid 4.5 million whites hold a monopoly on political and economic power while the Black majority of 21 million is deprived of all citizenship and human rights. Since 1960 over 3.5 million Blacks have been forcibly removed from their homes in "white areas" to barren labor reserves known as bantustans. In the bantustans 25% of Black children die before the age of five.
- FACT:** The City University of New York (CUNY) through its investment portfolio is supporting the racist system of apartheid to the tune of over \$6 million.
- FACT:** CUNY has investments in U.S. corporations and banks that play a direct role in maintaining white minority rule in S. Africa through bank loans, sales of goods to the military, and taxes to the Government.
- FACT:** For example, CUNY has \$148,500 worth of stock in CITICORP, the world's largest private lender to South Africa. CITICORP has participated in over \$2 billion in loans to South Africa including recent loans of \$250 million to the Government and \$100 million to AECI, South Africa's largest explosives company.

In response to university complicity in apartheid, students, faculty and alumni around the country have forced divestment of over \$175 million in forty schools' stock linked to South Africa. At Harvard University alone, \$51 million in funds invested in CITICORP were unloaded.
